They were the Grand Prize Winners of the 2005 Florilège Vocal de Tours International Choir Competition in France and winners of the European Grand Prix Choral Competition. The Singers have been featured in concerts throughout England, France, Spain, The Netherlands, Germany, and Italy on three European concert tours. They have been invited to perform at conventions of the American Choral Directors Association and Music Educators National Conference. The Singers have recorded seven compact disc recordings which are available through Heartrise Music and BuythisCD.com. The University of Utah Singers is an ensemble of approximately 45 singers and is open to any university student who exhibits advanced vocal and musicianship skills, as well as a high level of commitment and dedication to the art of choral singing.
